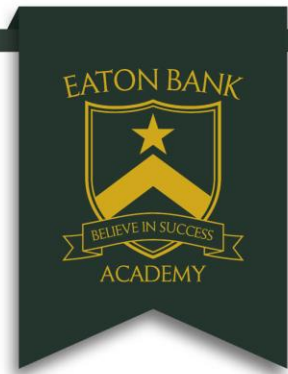

Year 7: Student-Led Learning

I am writing to inform you about a new programme to support your child's academic progress here at Eaton Bank Academy. Throughout the remainder of Year 7, students will be expected to complete a series of student-led learning tasks to support their progress in subjects they are finding more challenging, and stretch their ability in others.

Every student will be given certain subjects to focus on based around their reports and progress throughout the year, whilst activities in core will be completed to reflect on their progress. Students will be expected to spend a minimum of 45 minutes per week on these activities, selecting activities and topics that are most suitable to them.
